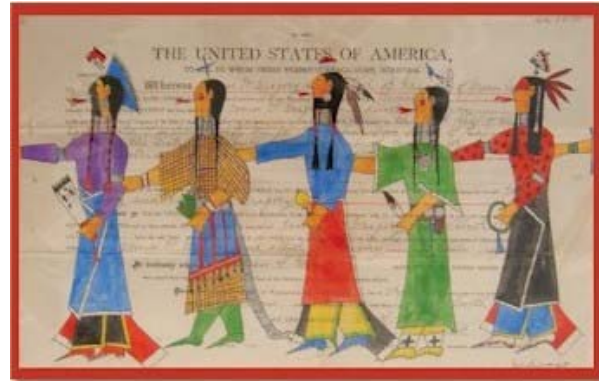

## January Guest Speaker: Colleen Hicks Executive Director, Museum of the American Indian

Colleen's paternal grandfather was a Native American and her maternal grandmother was a Daughter of the American Revolution. Colleen has worked with nonprofits for the last twenty years.

**The Museum of the American Indian**, a little known treasure of Marin County, sits on the site of a Coast Miwok Village – discovered in 1967 during construction activity in Novato. The Museum houses a large collection of Coast Miwok artifacts and other collections representing Native American cultures from across the entire continent. It also serves as an educational center.
